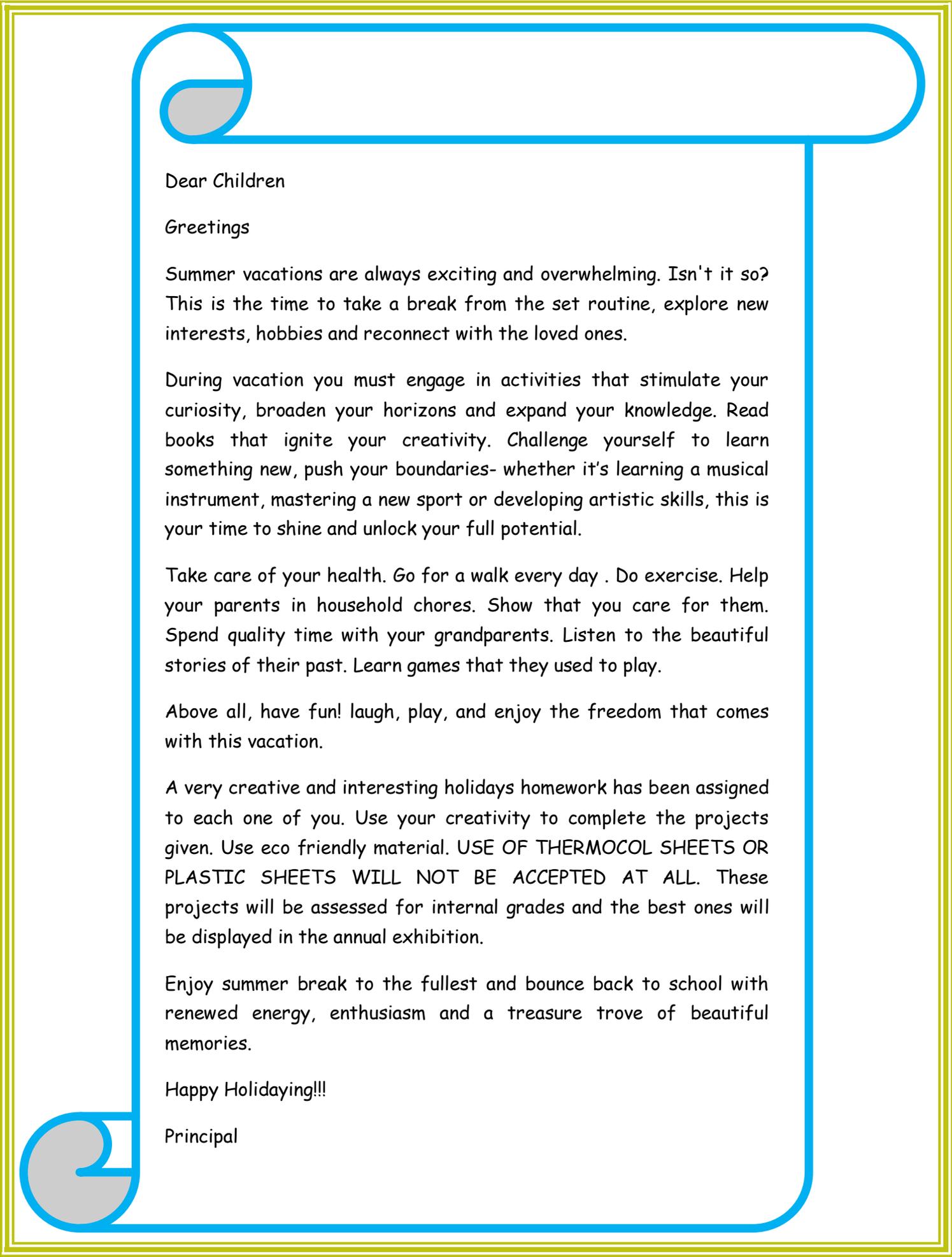
Above all, have fun! laugh, play, and enjoy the freedom that comes with this vacation.

Amazing Artificial Intelligence

❖ **(Roll no. 1 to 15)**

Chatbot Creator (Scratch/Block-based Coding) - Students have to create a simple chatbot using a platform like Scratch

Hints-

- Project Idea: A chatbot that answers questions about a specific topic (e.g., facts about animals, historical events, a favorite book character). They would pre-program questions and answers.
- Deliverable: The Scratch project link/file and a brief explanation of how their chatbot works and what challenges they faced.
- Tools Used: Scratch, Machine Learning for Kids (an extension for Scratch).

❖ **(Roll no. 16 to 30)**

AI Art Explorer (Using Online AI Art Tools)- Students use a child-friendly AI art generator (like DALL-E Mini, Adobe Firefly, or similar safe online tools) to create images based on text prompts.

Students have to create a collage of their favorite AI-generated images with the prompts they used, and a short reflection on what they learned about AI's creativity and limitations.

Hints-

- Project Idea: Create a series of images (e.g., "A robot dog playing in a futuristic park," "A space alien riding a bicycle on the moon").
- Experiment with different descriptive words and see how the AI changes the output.

❖ **(Roll no. 30 onwards)**

AI Ethics Story/Comic Strip: - Students have to create a short story or comic strip that explores a simple ethical dilemma related to AI. Introduce the idea that AI, while helpful, can have consequences and raises important questions regarding ethical concerns of A.I (e.g., fairness, privacy, job displacement).

Hints :- The story/comic strip can cover the following ethical point related to A.I

- A robot that makes a mistake because of biased training data.
- A story about privacy concerns with facial recognition cameras.
- A future scenario where robots do all the chores – what are the pros and cons?
