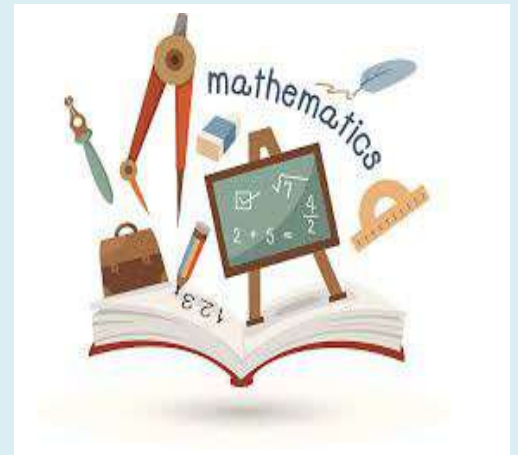

## STIMULATING SCIENCE

### Roll No- 1 to 5

#### **Evolution of sutures-**

Make a model showing how ancient civilizations used ant jaws or silk threads for stitching wounds, moving to modern dissolvable synthetic polymers, and finally to "smart" bandages that change color when an infection is detected.

(You can Make a 3-section timeline on cardboard. Make wounds using clay, place ants holding edges(Then), Stitch using real silk/nylon thread on foam sheet (Now), and place gel patch with LED underneath (Next)).

**Also prepare a Chart** that shows how stitching methods evolved from natural materials to smart infection-detecting bandages.

### Roll No- 6 to 10

#### **Bio Printing Skin-**

Make a model showing how skin grafts evolved from basic bandages to lab-grown skin and finally to 3D bioprinters that "print" cells directly onto wounds.

(Take a doll or a mannequin arm. Show three stages- Bandage, graft, printer. Use glue gun as 'Bioprinter nozzle'. Add clay layers as skin (Epidermis/dermis). Press glue gun button, show layer by layer printing. Divide stages clearly).

**Also make a wall hanging** that shows how skin is "printed" layer by layer, just like a real bioprinter builds tissue.

### Roll No- 11 to 15

## **Ocean CleanUp Systems**

Make a model showing how ocean cleaning evolved from manual effort to smart technology. Through your model showing how we move from simple fishing nets to giant floating traps, and finally to tiny 'science-bots' that eat up pollution. It proves that with better technology, we can make the water crystal clear again by 2050.

(You can use blue sheet as water, add plastic waste. Show nets (thread), pipes (straws), nano-bots (Robo-fish). Label all stages. Move thread net- Collect waste. Show demonstration).

**Also make a Wall Hanging** made of recycled plastic titled "Healing our Oceans".

### **Roll No- 16 to 20**

#### **Reforestation via drones-**

Make a model showing how we are moving from planting trees one-by-one by hand to using high-speed drones. By 2050, these smart drones will scan the ground and fire "seed bombs" into the soil to regrow entire forests in just a few days.

(You can create land with paper trees. Show manual planting, planes, and drone using cardboard. Draw flight path).

Also make a wall hanging that explains the importance of forests.

### **Roll No- 21 to 25**

#### **Irrigation Evolution -**

Make a model that shows how irrigation moved from simple water wheels to modern pipes. It looks ahead to a future where "Smart Roots" and hydrogels will automatically sense when a plant is thirsty, saving every drop of water while keeping the soil healthy and green.

(You can make Persian wheel (cardboard), drip system (pipes), and hydrogel beads for smart roots. Show water flow arrows).

**Also prepare a Wall hanging** showing water saving techniques.

### **Roll No- 26 to 30**

**The Healing House-**Make a model that shows the journey of human shelter from natural mud shelters to modern apartments, leading to a future where homes are built from "living" materials. These futuristic houses act like living organisms—they can repair their own walls, filter out toxins from the air, and create a perfectly healthy environment for the families living inside.

This model shows how homes evolved into eco-friendly and self-sustaining structures.

(You can make mud house (clay), modern house (cardboard), future house (sponge + plants). Add LED for modern/future).

**Also prepare a placard** on— "Green Homes = Healthy Life"

### **Roll No- 31 to 35**

#### **Waste to Energy-**

This model explains how we change smelly garbage into clean electricity for our homes. It follows the journey from simple trash pits to modern factories, leading to a future where every bit of waste is recycled into powerful, "green" fuel that heals our planet.

(You can build a three-part display featuring a miniature landfill, a modern incinerator plant, and a futuristic "Bio-Reactor" that uses glowing liquids and LEDs to show trash being converted into clean power).

**Also prepare a chart** that explains how waste is transformed into useful energy through modern technologies."

### **Roll No- 36 to 40**

#### **Stress Management-**

This project traces our journey from ancient meditation practices under trees to modern counseling rooms. It explores a future where "smart sensory rooms" use light, sound, and bio-feedback to instantly calm the brain, showing how we can heal our mental health across different eras.

(How it can be made: Create a three-part display featuring a clay figure meditating in a forest, a modern office with a relaxation chair, and a futuristic "Calm Pod" made from a silver dome with color-changing LEDs.)

**Also make a poster** that shows the transformation from a stressed mind to a peaceful and happy life through healthy habits.

### **Roll No- 41 onwards**

#### **Healing the Air (Vehicles)-**

This project tracks the shift from old, smoke-breathing engines to modern electric cars that keep our streets quiet. It looks ahead to a future of "Hydrogen Power," where vehicles run on the most abundant element in the universe and release only pure water vapor instead of smoke, helping to heal our atmosphere.

(How it can be made: You can use a vintage car with cotton-wool "smoke," a modern electric car with a charging plug, and a futuristic hydrogen car made of sleek silver material with a small "exhaust" that drops real water into a tiny bowl).

**Also make a Placard** showing "Zero Emission Future".
